

**Seaholm Band Booster Meeting
September 24, 2015
Minutes**

The meeting was called to order at 6:35 pm by Heather Guise, Band Booster President

1. Call to Order, Welcome and President's Report
 - a. Heather Guise welcomed everyone to the meeting, distributed a list of band booster officers and committees and introduced members of the executive board.
 - b. Heather made a motion to approve the January minutes, Shayne Gordon seconded the motion and Courteney Gettel approved the motion.
2. Treasurer's Report
 - a. Pam Righter referenced two budgets that were distributed, a proposed budget for this school year and one that shows budget vs. actual.
 - b. Pam reported that the band has a surplus. She is recommending we spend while our students are here at Seaholm. A large portion of the surplus will go toward instrument purchases.
 - c. A line item will be added for expenses associated with the flag planting fundraiser.
 - d. Jane O'Shea moved to approve the 2015-2016 budget. Courteney Gettel seconded and the group approved.
3. Director's Report – Tim Cibor gave a brief review and update. Highlights are noted below.
 - a. Tim reported that this is a busy week for the kids. Marching rehearsal tonight, home football game tomorrow and Groves Invitational on Saturday.
 - b. The Groves Invitational is a great opportunity for the kids to see other quality bands perform.
 - c. At the next home football game (Oct. 9) the drum feature will be incorporated as well as the third song, Can't Buy Me Love.
 - d. No marching practice on Sept. 30th.
 - e. Jazz Band auditions will take place immediately after marching season concludes. All students who try out will be placed in one of the two jazz bands.
 - f. Tim introduced student teacher, Maddie Aikens.
4. Committee Reports
 - a. Uniforms (Shayne Gordon)
 - All students have a uniform.
 - There are enough volunteers for the weekend band events.

- b. Fundraising (Courteney Gettel)
 - Flower Power fundraiser coming home soon. Money raised goes into student accounts. Students will earn 50% of every purchase.
- c. Dinner Dance (Courteney Gettel and Kimberley DeClark)
 - The dinner dance will take place on March 18, 2016.
 - The chairs are hoping to re-use the decorations from last year.
 - It's not too early to acquire advertisers for the program.
 - Both jazz bands play during the event.
 - Event sells out every year.
- d. May Fundraiser (Courteney Gettel)
 - Kids (with supervision from parents) plant flags around town on Memorial Day weekend with flyer attached asking for a donation.
 - In the past, this fundraiser has brought in \$13,000.
 - All monies raised will be evenly divided among the participating students and deposited into their student accounts.
- e. Merchandise (Nancy Shiner)
 - 40 families participated in the merchandise sale and \$161 was raised for the band.
 - If there is interest, another order can be placed.
 - Band magnets and "I love band" t-shirts are being sold at the home football games. So far, \$340 has been raised selling these items.
- f. Hydration Team (Carol and Tim Lamb)
 - The first homes games went smoothly.
 - Still looking for additional volunteers to help distribute waters to the kids during the games.
 - Check the sign-up genius to volunteer.
- g. Senior Night (Angie Righter and Lauri Dailey)
 - There are 60 seniors this year.
 - Senior night is Oct. 9, before the football game.
 - There is an announcer and a photographer. Another photographer may be needed.
